City-County Council Clears Way for Over \$65 Million in New Capital Investment, Retention of 1,733 Jobs, Addition of 745 New Jobs

(Indianapolis) Earlier this evening, the Indianapolis Marion County City-County Council passed four proposals that provided incentives for expansion in economic revitalization areas that desperately need new investment. Economic Development Committee Chairman, Jeff Cardwell stated, "This is a great day for our city. Passage of these proposals will allow for over \$65 million in new capital investment, retention of 1,733 jobs, and create an additional 745 jobs."

Each of these proposals was approved by a bi-partisan vote of the Council's Economic Development Committee and the Full Council.

Carrier Corporation: Invest nearly \$50 million in new equipment, manufacturing, and buildings. Retain approximately 1,450 jobs; add an additional 250 new jobs.

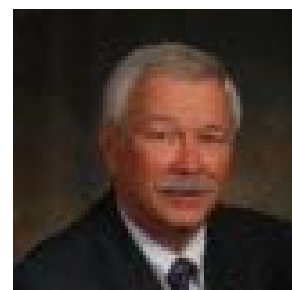
Stonegate Mortgage: By 2016, will invest \$760,000 in IT equipment, add 300 new employees, and add \$18,058,560 in average annual payroll.

Enterprise Leasing Company of Indianapolis: Move 57 employees from Hamilton to Marion County, rehabilitate over 27,000 square feet of office/warehouse building at a cost of \$2.1 million.

Comlux America, LLC: Investing over \$14 million in capital improvement, creating 25-50 construction jobs. Adding 112 full-time jobs, increasing total payroll to approximately \$30,400,000 annually for 400 employees with a continued focus on partnerships with Butler University, Purdue University, and other local colleges and universities to attract and retain local talent.
