### Regional Bikeways Plan

Indy Connect is continuing to refine Central Indiana's Regional Bikeway Plan and is asking residents to help. The Regional Bikeways Plan will take bike planning to the next level by examining priorities and developing a long range program for bicycle facilities that considers construction costs, funding sources and timing of implementation. This planning step is needed to prioritize bike projects that have been identified throughout the years and match them with available funding. We are asking you to help us re-focus on priorities and guide our investment to create a functional, convenient and connected bikeways system.

#### **Benefits of a Regional Bikeways Plan include:**

- Bike paths and sidewalks that connect to bus routes, rail transit and other destinations.
- More bike racks and secure bicycle storage lockers, with the help of the City of Indianapolis and surrounding counties.
- More opportunities for people to bike or walk in areas separated from vehicles - like today's Monon Trail.
- Bike lanes on some existing roadways.
