MORE REBUILDINDY PROJECTS PLANNED FOR SOUTH NEIGHBORHOODS

RebuildIndy is Mayor Ballard's initiative to restore deteriorating thoroughfares, residential streets, sidewalks and bridges, and other City assets.

From 2010 - 2013, about \$500 million in infrastructure improvements were made throughout Marion County through the RebuildIndy program.

Still, the need is great, particularly in light of the 2013-2014 winter season — the harshest in Indianapolis history — which has left many of our streets in disrepair.

Under the leadership of Mayor Greg Ballard, Indianapolis has a plan to address our City's sweeping infrastructure needs without raising taxes. The plan is called RebuildIndy 2, and it will allow DPW to continue the successful RebuildIndy program with up to \$350 million in projects over three years.

NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENTS

The projects planned with RebuildIndy 2 will improve aging infrastructure in neighborhoods throughout Indianapolis and increase pedestrian and motorist safety.

If approved, RebuildIndy 2 would fund more than \$50 million in sidewalks and more than \$100 million in street repairs — including all of our highest priority street resurfacing needs in Marion County.

Furthermore, the RebuildIndy 2 plan supports the recently adopted Complete Streets ordinance that requires DPW to achieve a better connected Indianapolis with sidewalks, trails and greenways.



WHEN CAN WORK BEGIN?

These needed projects will begin as soon as the RebuildIndy 2 plan gains approval by the City-County Council. Citizens are encouraged to contact their City-County Councillors and urge them to support this plan to invest in our neighborhoods.

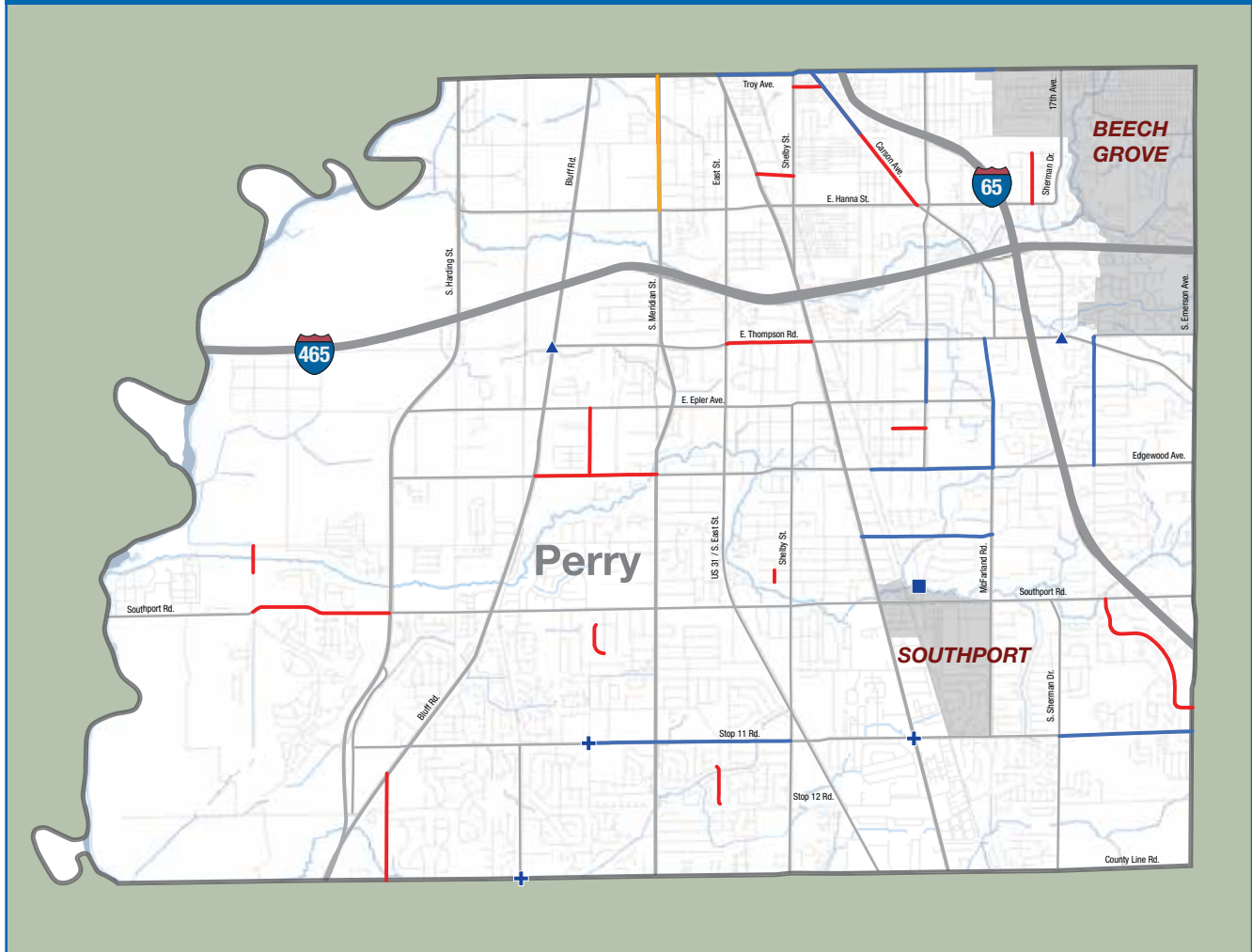
