HVHA BOARD AT WORK

The HVHA board felt that many of you may not be aware of the work that is being done by the board. We are adding this segment to the Newsletter to keep you informed.

<u>January 2014 Meeting</u>: The topic of raising the membership dues was discussed and voted on in order to get the newsletter and information mailed to all Hill Valley residents. The website update and a new internet provider was discussed as well as agreed upon. Please take a look at the website, Charlie Eldridge as put a lot of time into it. We are still looking for a webmaster and membership liaison to replace Charlie as he has resigned from those positions.

<u>*February 2014 Meeting*</u>: The need for increasing membership was discussed. The board also looked at the budget that was greatly impacted by the lack of paid members and the over 10,000 spent on the snow removal. We need your assistance in getting more of your neighbors to join the association. We would also like to thank all members that were able to send dues as well as some who sent additional donations.

<u>March 2014 Meeting</u>: Dan Moiarity, Marion County Trustee was a visitor at this meeting. Dan was not campaigning and was there for the Charitable Cause Initiative. He came to discuss with the board the need for volunteers to help sort and audit items they have collected to help the needy of Marion County. The trustees' office has worked with 34 local charities and ministries and has been able to distribute 1.1 million dollars of assistance to the needy. MOBILE APP TO REPORT CITY PROBLEMS

Did you know that Indianapolis has created a new way for the public to track problems in our city such as potholes, stray animals, high grass/weeds, abandoned vehicles? It is a mobile app called "RequestIndy." It can be downloaded on your smart phone, and is extremely easy to navigate. It actually allows you to take a photo of the problem and send it immediately to the Mayor's Action Center. Give it a try! It may be downloaded <u>here</u> for the IPhone or <u>here</u> for the Android (they are on the right hand side of the <u>Mayor's Action Center</u>).

FROM THE MEMBERSHIP LIAISON

We have received several comments concerning the membership; however, if a mandatory association is not formed at the time a subdivision or a condo project is built, and is in the covenants, it is next to impossible to make a mandatory association at that point. The only way to make it mandatory is to have 100% agreement of all the homeowners to sign off on one. If we cannot encourage more people to join, we assure you that a drive to get everyone on board would never be successful. The simple truth is that if everyone would join, we could actually *lower* the dues a little instead of *raising* them. There were 54% of the total residents that paid their dues and became members in 2013 and we are hoping for more in 2014. Do you know your membership status?
