FALL LEAF PICK-UP

During leaf collection season, you can dispose of 40 bags of leaves each week with your regular trash. The 2021 collection season begins on Monday, November 8. This service is free of charge.

Place leaves in large plastic trash bags, and place the bags on the street by 7 a.m. on your collection day. Residents should refrain from using paper bags as they deteriorate and fall apart in wet weather. Keep the leaf bags 3 feet away from your cart collection area and out of sidewalks and public rights-of-way.

Never rake leaves into the street. Leaf season is a great time to clear your nearby storm drain inlets and keep them maintained to prevent drainage and flooding problems.



Burning leaves is illegal in Marion County as it releases harmful particles into our air. Outside of the four-week leaf season, you may place bags of leaves inside your trash cart or take them to the Citizens' Transfer Station on Saturdays.

Last year, DPW collected about 5,500 tons of leaves from residents. The collected leaves will be composted at South Side Landfill and in the spring, the mulch will be available at no cost to residents. <u>South Side Landfill's</u> address is 2561 Kentucky Ave., the phone number is (317) 247-6808.

If you need to dispose of leaves outside of leaf collection season, you can take them to the <u>Citizens' Transfer Station</u> at 2324 S. Belmont Ave. on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The fee is \$2 per carload and \$5 per truckload. For more information visit <u>indy.gov/activity/leaf-collection-season</u>.


PERRY PARK ICE ARENA

Looking for a family fun activity? Why not try ice skating at Perry Park Ice Arena? This is a great way to spend quality time together.

Perry Park offers an ice skating rink, seasonal outdoor pool, outdoor basketball and tennis courts, two shelters with picnic tables, a playground, and a sports field.

The park's NHL-sized ice rink features four locker rooms and a concession stand and is home of the South Stars High School Hockey Club, the South Indy Youth Hockey Association, Total Package Hockey's Center of Excellence – Indy, and the Sycamore Ice Skating Club.

The skating rink's season normally runs from the middle of September through April. The schedule is subject to change so calling ahead is always recommended. Don't forget to check the Perry Park Facebook page for the monthly Public Skating calendar and possible schedule changes. Please note that Public Sessions are limited to 50 people. Admission is \$5 for children (17 & under), \$6 for adults, and \$3 for non-skating guests. Skate rentals are \$3 and



Skate Helpers can be rented for \$5. Masks are required at all times including while on the ice. Social distancing from other guests outside your immediate household is strongly encouraged. Call today and arrange a visit!
