## ANNUAL HVHA NEIGHBORHOOD CHRISTMAS DECORATION CONTEST



It is hard to believe we are talking about Christmas decorations already, but it is one of our favorite times of the year. In early December, a small group of board members/volunteers will drive around our neighborhood and pick our favorite Christmas decorations. Winners will be selected, and the winners will receive gift cards from local restaurants if they have a paid membership in the Homeowners Association. ### **FALL LEAF PICK-UP**

Beginning in early November through early December, up to 40 bags of leaves will be picked up each week free of charge (we do not know the exact dates of collection yet but we will notify those that have signed up for the electronic version of the newsletter). Place leaves in large plastic trash bags and place the bags on the street by 7 a.m. on your collection day. Residents should refrain from using paper bags as they deteriorate and fall apart in wet weather. Keep the leaf bags 3-5 feet away from

your cart collection area and out of sidewalks and public rights-of-way.

Leaf season is a great time to clear your nearby storm drain inlets and keep them maintained to prevent drainage and flooding problems. *Burning leaves is illegal* in Marion County as it releases harmful particles into our air. Illegal burning may result in fines up to \$2.500.





I (Patty Graff) recently learned that Dorothy M. Scheidler had passed away. However, it made me think that I didn't publish any information about Dorothy's husband, Stephen H. Scheidler, who had passed away in 2015. Not only do I have a heavy heart with learning of Dorothy's death, but it made me realize that I had failed to publish information of Steve's death. Dorothy graduated from Clarksburg High School in 1945. She enjoyed arranging flowers, playing euchre, and watching local sporting events. She always had time for ice cream and cherry pie. Dorothy greatest love was her family, she always found time to support her children and grandchildren in all their activities and special events. Both Stephen and Dorothy were charter members of St. Barnabas Catholic Church. These two beautiful souls hosted our HVHA Christmas Board Meeting every year in their home. They invited all of us board members to their home for our annual December meeting. It never failed that every year Dorothy would have some of her tasty homemade pastries ready and waiting for all of us. Dorothy had a gift of being the sweetest and most hospitable hostess ever! ### **PARKING ON THE STREET**

In addition, vehicles parked on opposite sides of the street at the same location makes is tight to make it through and impossible to get emergency vehicles through. If there is not enough room to park in your garage, please use your driveways for parking.

### HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND TOXIC DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

Hazardous household waste consists of items such as cleaners, paint, motor oil, gasoline, batteries, weed and insect poisons that are dangerous to our environment. These items may be dropped off at any of the city's free ToxDrop sites. Our closest drop off point is the Perry Township Government



Center at 4925 S. Shelby Street. You may drop off items on the 2nd Saturday of each month from 9am – 2pm.

## REQUEST INDY MOBILE APP

Did you know that Indianapolis has created a way for the public to track problems in our city such as potholes, stray animals, high grass/weeds, abandoned vehicles? It is a mobile app called "RequestIndy." It can be downloaded on your smart phone and is extremely easy to navigate. It allows you to take a photo of the problem and send it immediately to the Mayor's Action Center. Give it a try!


### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS HAS TWO VACANCIES**
